



## Centralised Match for Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine in Victoria in 2024

The PMCV website opened on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023 for registration for the Centralised Match for Continuing Trainees. Applications close on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2023. [Link](#)

The steps include:

- Registration
- Completion of CV form
- Nomination of referees
- Nomination of Health Services

Ensure that your referees are able to submit their reports by 29<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

Only the Health Services that you have nominated will be able to access your details, and include you on their preference list. You must also apply directly to the Health Services.

You may reorder your Health Service preference list until 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023, including deleting Health Services from your preference list.

You may withdraw from the match up until 5PM on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023. After this date the results of the match are binding.

Results of the match will be published on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

### **Part-time Trainees**

Appointments for part-time positions will be made outside the match. If you have not been able to secure a part-time position for 2024 you may participate in the centralised match, in the understanding that it is for full-time positions.

### **Joining Geriatric Medicine from another RACP Specialty Program**

Candidates who have commenced Advanced Training in another RACP speciality program are eligible to participate in this match for Continuing Trainees.

### **The rules**

The results of the match are binding.

There is no appeals process for missed closing dates or errors in submitting preference lists.
