



Centralised Match for Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine

The match is designed for applicants:

- who hold general registration with APHRA
- who are eligible for Advanced Training with RACP
- who are applying for full-time employment

Part-time training

Part-time appointments may be made outside the match. Applicants who are unable to secure a part-time appointment prior to the match, are eligible to participate in the match, in the understanding that the match is for full-time positions.

Provisional Registration with APHRA

Medical practitioners eligible for Advanced Training with RACP and holding APHRA provisional registration should contact PMCV for guidance regarding eligibility to enter the match. [Link](#)

If permitted to participate in the match, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the Health Services are aware of any special supervisory requirements specified by APHRA at the time of application.

Medical practitioners who are not able to participate in the match may still be eligible for appointment. Direct contact with the Health Services of interest is suggested.

Note:

- The match is for full-time and full-year appointments. Other applicants should seek contact Health Services directly.
- The results of the match are binding. Do not enter the match, or list a Health Service, if you are not prepared to accept the outcome of the match.
