



## Specialist Training in Geriatric Medicine

Entry requirements for the Geriatric Medicine Advanced Training program include:

- a) completion of Basic Physician Training of RACP
- b) current medical registration
- c) appointment to an accredited training position

Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine comes under the auspices of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians (RACP). It requires 36 months of full-time equivalent training. Once all requirements are satisfied the trainee may apply for Fellowship of the RACP. <https://www.racp.edu.au/>

VGMTP does not award certification on completion of training. This is the role of RACP.

VGMTP follows the Advanced Training curriculum of RACP and coordinates the centralised match for Advanced Training positions in Victoria.
